Eligibility: (1) Any student in Technical education who chooses a career based on interests and abilities and where the workforce is employed by 25% or less of their gender. (2) Must maintain at least 9 credits. (3) Participant in NTO program for no more than 6 semesters. (4) Must have a developed Educational Plan of Action. (6) Must have a recommendation by program instructor.
